Almut-Barbara Renger is Professor of Ancient Religion and Culture and their Reception History at the Institute for the Scientific Study of Religion at Freie Universität Berlin. Since 2010 she is Associate at Harvard University. Her research, scholarship and teaching focus on the creation and dissemination of myths, legends, idols and icons in high and popular culture. Primarily, she is concerned with the Classical Tradition. Articles and books explore the continuing effects of Ancient Greek and Roman literature and culture throughout history into the present day. Of particular concern are charismatic teachers and leaders, their self-conception and attraction to followers, as well as the topics of discipleship and the transmission and transformation of religious and philosophical knowledge.
